Re: NUT Unions' Industrial Action

Further to my letter sent out via email earlier this week regarding NUT taking industrial action on Tuesday 5th July, I can confirm that a substantial number of our teachers are in the NUT and taking strike action, which means that we cannot safely keep the school open for all pupils.

The school will, however, be kept open for Year 12 students only, who will be expected to attend as normal. Whilst we will endeavour to provide education as normal for these students during this important period of their school career, this may not always be the case and it is likely that some lessons will be private study, supervised by a member of staff. The health and safety of the students will, as always, be a top priority.

We hope that this action, which is not against the school itself, but is part of a national campaign about changes to pensions, workload and conditions of service, will be resolved as soon as possible.
