Students should meet in the Lower School Playground. The coach will depart at 8.00am and will return to the school at approximately 7.00 pm.

Students will need to take a packed lunch/refreshments. Students entitled to free school meals should collect a packed lunch from the canteen prior to getting on the coach. There are eating places around the Arena for students to purchase food. Please be aware the venue will be extremely busy so there are likely to be long queues and potentially higher prices.

Students do not need to wear school uniform but should wear 'smart casual', it is a fairly active day and students should dress accordingly. Please bring sunscreen, plenty of water, waterproof clothing, as required dependant on the weather forecast.

Please make sure that your son/daughter adheres to the Arena's rules:

- Only carton drinks are allowed into the arena, no glass bottles (plastic bottles will have their lids removed at the entrance).
- No flagpoles, Go Pros or Selfie sticks
- One small bag only per person allowed into the Arena (to reduce time getting through Security).

Please be aware there are limited places available for this trip. If your son/daughter would like to attend, please sign and return the attached medical consent form and permission slip to Mrs Haggis in C Block, Resources. These forms are a legal requirement, if we do not receive them your son/daughter will not be able to participate.

There is a voluntary contribution of £13.00 to cover travel costs. Please make cheques payable to Prospect School. There is no option to make a Parentpay payment for this trip.
