As you are aware the GCSE exams are now finished, that is 53 separate exams over 23 days completed which amounts to over 4300 separate exams taken by year 11 this year. So my first thing to do is to thank you for the support you gave to the school and your year 11 student through this time. They really deserve the rest they are currently getting!

You may be starting to think about what comes next for your son/daughter, so I wanted to take the time to outline the next steps.

1. Leavers Ball - we cannot wait to see the students all dressed up and having a well-earned celebration. The Leavers Ball is taking place on 13th July and students need to arrive at **Trunkwell House (RG7 2AT) at 7.00pm**. They will then need to be picked up between **10.40pm-11.00pm**.

2. Results Day - 24th August 2017 Sixth Form common room 10.00am-12.00pm.

We are looking forward to seeing as many students and parents as we can to help celebrate, jump up and down with, mop tears (yes there will be some) and advise on the next steps in their education.

Once results have been issued, students who are intending to stay on at sixth form and have met all of the criteria highlighted in their conditional offer, will be able to enrol immediately with a senior member of staff.

For those who have yet to apply, wish to change their options, or have not quite met the entry criteria for their conditional offer, a member of the sixth form team will be on hand to advise and enrol them on the most appropriate courses.

For those students who have not met the criteria for the sixth form, Mr T Smith (Head of Careers) will be available to ensure students are on the right pathway for their future.

If students are unavailable on results day, they can drop into the sixth form common room on Friday 1st September to speak to a member of the sixth form team between 9.00am and 12.00pm. Term begins for all students on 7th September.
