Dear Parent/Carer

As part of the work on the Normanisation of England that your son/daughter will soon be studying, I have organised an exciting enrichment trip to Reading Museum on Thursday 24th January 2019.

We will be attending two workshops at The Museum. This trip provides a fantastic opportunity to gain further knowledge of the Bayeux Tapestry.

We will travel to Reading by bus, leaving the school at 1.15pm. Students will need to meet staff in D Block Reception, for a prompt departure. The session finishes at 4pm, where students will be escorted back to school. If you prefer, please indicate on the reply slip that you give permission for your son/daughter to leave staff at the museum and make their own way home.

Students are required to wear school uniform, and are reminded that they are representing the school. High standards of behaviour are expected throughout the trip and normal school rules apply.

There are 45 spaces for students on this trip and they will be allocated on a 'first come, first served' basis. Should your son/daughter wish to attend this trip, please return the permission slip and parental and medical consent forms. The school will accept either cash or cheques (made payable to Prospect School). Please bring cash/cheque to Mrs Haggis in Resources in C Block. We are asking for a voluntary contribution towards the cost of the entrance ticket of £3 per student. As we are travelling by public bus, students will need to use their bus pass or buy a bus ticket on the day. If your son/daughter is required to purchase a bus ticket, they will need the exact money for their fare on the day. Bus tickets cost as follows: Under 18s – single £1.50 or return £2.50.

If there are insufficient contributions the event may have to be cancelled. If you have any concerns regarding payment, please contact me directly.
