## **PROSPECT SCHOOL Uniform Policy**

### **Uniform and appearance**

Effective teaching and learning needs proper organization and this starts with a smart and tidy appearance which helps to instil discipline and pride in appearance in students, and reduces the risk of distraction in lessons. School uniform is part of school life and has many benefits both to the school and to parents. It ensures that the image the school creates is one of pride, industry and identifiable purpose which is so important these days. It is helpful to parents in that there is no element of competition and no confusion over what is acceptable for school wear. It is not considered that extremes of fashion are desirable. Our school uniform requirements can be found on the school website along with procedures for non-compliance

### **SCHOOL UNIFORM**

### **BOYS' UNIFORM**

- Plain black 'V' neck sweat shirt with Prospect logo.
- The correct Key Stage school tie.
- A white shirt buttoned to the collar.
- Black tailored trousers.
- Plain black (low heel) shoes.
- Plain black socks.
- No more than one plain stud in each ear.
- No more than one ring, on each hand.

### **GIRLS' UNIFORM**

- Plain black 'V' neck sweat shirt with Prospect logo.
- The correct Key Stage school tie.
- A white shirt buttoned to the collar.
- Black tailored trousers/skirt or black shalwar, black skirt and black head scarf.
- Plain black (low heel) shoes.
- Plain black socks.

- No more than one plain stud in each ear.
- No more than one ring, on each hand.

**The following are not considered acceptable:**

- Apart from the one plain stud in each ear, any bodily piercing of any form.
- Extreme hairstyles. This particularly involves hair with 'tramlines' or patterns.
- Necklaces or any other jewellery.
- Jeans worn as trousers.
- Denim jackets
- Any sweat shirts without the Prospect logo, including hooded variety
- Brown shoes, trainers, Ugg boots, boots and canvas shoes.
- Body Warmers

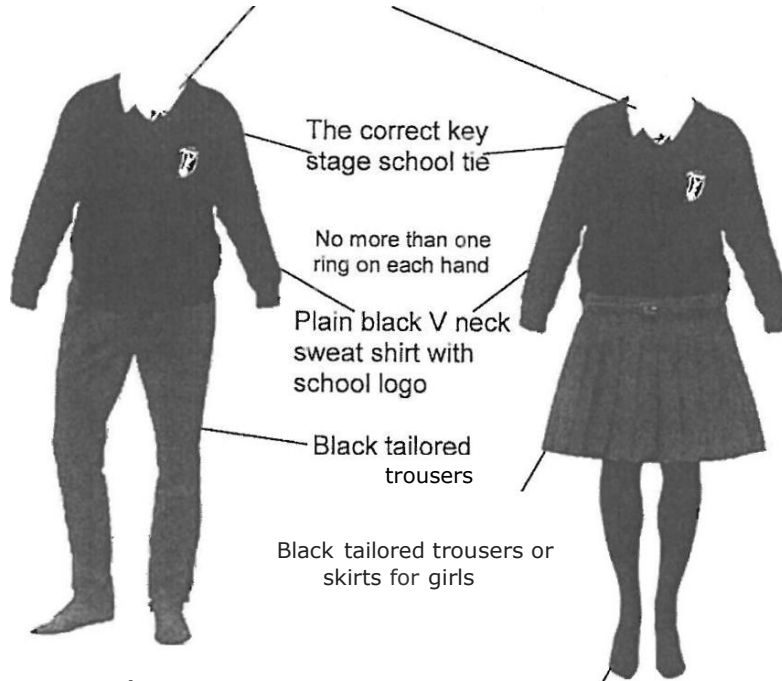
All students in years 7- 11 are expected to follow the above dress code.

## **Process for non-compliance with school uniform**

Pupils who do not comply with the uniform code will be challenged by staff. There are a number of possible courses of action depending on circumstances at the time in question.

Possible courses of action are as follows:

1. Parent & Carer contacted and pupil sent home to get the correct uniform
2. Text sent regarding area of concern.
3. Withdrawal from lessons within our Inclusion Learning Centre or Support Area.
4. Parent & Carer may bring correct uniform into school.
5. Pupil returns to lessons with expectation that uniform will be corrected by the following day

The school does not expect a note to be given to a pupil for an indefinite period of time. The expectation that the correct uniform will be worn as soon as possible (ie next day)

Every case will be treated individually based on the relevant circumstances.

Piercing /Jewellery and extreme hair styles and colouring will be sanctioned in the same way as above
