- Protection is one element of safeguarding. It is about promoting the health, well - being and human rights of individuals.
- It is about identifying and taking action to prevent abuse and neglect.

Key terms:

Abuse - action by another individual that causes significant harm.

Neglect - failing to provide care that causes or is likely to cause harm to an individual

Protection - detecting and preventing harm and abuse



1.1 Explain protection in relation to safeguarding



- Safeguarding includes protecting children, young people and adults from abuse and maltreatment.
- It is about valuing an individual's unique needs.
- Safeguarding also underpins the provision of high-quality service and is an essential part of a health and social care practitioner's role.

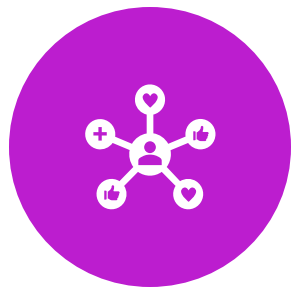
1.1 Explain protection in relation to safeguarding



To identify abuse, staff must be aware of signs and indicators and contexts in which abuse may take place.



To be able to act on their concerns, policies and procedures must be in place and legislation must be followed.



All organisations that have contact with children, young people and vulnerable adults must follow the safeguarding legislation and the settings must have policies in place.



All professionals that work in these organisations need to be aware of their own responsibilities and where they can get additional help and support
